2025 Camp Dates and Locations:

Primary: Grade 3-5 McCormick's Creek SP. June 16-20

SP. Camp Olivet. June 16-20 Senior: Grade 9-12 Camp Olivet. June 9-13

Camp Rules:

- **Dress Code:** Modest summer attire is appropriate. Modest (fingertip) length shorts, regular t-shirts/shirts (no midriff, no offensive or inappropriate messaging), tank tops with wide straps (no spaghetti straps), modest (no low-cut, no cut outs, no midriff) one-piece or tankini swimsuit for girls, boxer type shorts swimsuit for boys, and cover-up/t-shirt to wear to the pool. The key biblical word for all ages for camp dress code is Modesty! The camp leadership will have discretion on dress at camp and will have the authority to require campers to change if dress is inappropriate. Indiana State law requires shoes to be worn, at all times, except at the swimming pool. Camp leadership prefers tennis shoes rather than flip flops for most activities, however flip flops are appropriate for wearing to the pool and shower.
- **Electronic Devices:** Campers are not permitted to have any type of electronic devices including cell phones while at camp. The Camp Dean will collect all electronic devices and safely store them until the end of camp.
- Conduct: Camp staff requires all campers to respect the authority of Camp leadership.
 - 1. Grooming: Campers are expected to maintain good personal daily hygiene.

Junior: Grade 6-8

- 2. Language: Foul/abusive language is not permitted, including euphemisms/suggestive language.
- **3.** Body Art: Piercing pieces must not be worn at camp and inappropriate tattoo images must be covered while at camp.
- 4. Substance Use: Tobacco use, vaping, alcohol, illegal drugs and, etc. are strictly prohibited at camp.
- 5. Inappropriate Touch: Campers must not participate in public displays of affection or inappropriate and excessive touch while at camp.
- 6. Rule-of-Three: Campers should never be alone one-on-one with anyone, anywhere, at any time.
- 7. No-Go-Zones: Camp Rules posted on cabin doors will clearly identify No-Go-Zones in camp vicinity.
- 8. Physical/Verbal Abuse: Any form of physical or verbal abuse is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Weapons: No kind of weapon is permitted at camp.
- 10. Food: The camp provides all food and snacks. Please advise staff of special dietary needs.

Camp Instructions: What to bring to camp.

- Bedding: Bring your own pillows, sheets, blankets, etc. (Bunks w/ twin size mattress provided at camp.)
- Toiletry and Bathing items: Bring your own personal hygiene items. (Showers at camp are available daily)
- Appropriate Clothing: Bring a week's supply of clean clothing and shoes, including extra shoes appropriate for play, hiking, and for wearing to the shower and pool. (*See Camp Rules: Dress Code*)
- Flashlight with fully charged batteries: ("So let your light shine among men".)
- Sunscreen: (We recommend waterproof SPF 30 minimum)
- Insect Repellant: (Check for safe use on children)
- Modest no low-cut, no cut outs, no midriff swimsuit for girls, boxer type shorts swimsuit for boys and cover-up/t-shirt to wear to pool: (*See Camp Rules: Dress Code*)
- Towels: Bring enough towels for daily showers and swimming. (At least two towels)
- Small Fan: Junior and Senior Camp cabins are not air conditioned, small battery-operated fans are permitted. Primary Camp cabins are air conditioned; fans are not needed.
- Prescription Drugs: A week supply of personal prescription drugs in original prescription containers. (Turn in all prescription drugs to Camp Medical Staff at check-in)
